Faced down on the tarmac

Leaving for my flight to Israel on 7th October, I had a call from a friend in Israel. "Did you know there is a war on?" he asked. I did not, thinking it was just a minor incident. My flight was on schedule with clearance to fly, but when we landed the pilot told us of some security concerns. The bus that was to take us to the terminal came to an abrupt halt. The driver gave rapid instructions to get out and lie face down on the tarmac. We heard the loud bangs of rockets, and a girl next to me was in tears. After a few minutes, we got back on the bus, rushed through an empty airport and the quickest immigration process I ever experienced.

A camera crew from CNN were on our flight. We were featured with the captions "Citizens of Israel, we are at war" and "IDF sirens continue to warn in incoming rockets across Israel".

There were alarms and trips to the bomb shelter in the next few days, and planes flying overhead every night.

After several flight cancellations, I managed to fly back via Abu Dhabi, to the great relief of my family. Back in the UK, I took some time to process the experience. I grieve and mourn for my people, and for all the peoples of the region.

AN ENDING AND A NEW BEGINNING



Emma Holland writes

In July, I moved back to the UK after spending the last year in Kenya. The Lord really made it clear to me that it was right to be closer to home and family.

I have always wanted to work in an inner-city school, and so started pushing doors to live and work in London. Very quickly, I found a new job at a dream school and accommodation (with good friend from university), confirming in my spirit that it was right to be making this move.

So since September 2023, I have been working at a wonderful school in Camden, that serves the children living on a local council estate. Our school is extremely diverse regarding nationalities of the children, many who don't speak in English at home and predominantly following Islam. Lots of our children have only lived in the UK for a few years after fleeing their home countries because of war. It is a privilege to teach these children and to watch them flourish at school and in the community they live in.

Outside of work, I have joined a church called Holy Trinity Clapham (fun fact... it is the church William Wilberforce worshipped at!), and am getting plugged in with serving on teams and joining a small group.

Please pray for:

- strong friendships at church and work.
- boldness in my faith as I work in a team of teachers who are either Muslim or have no belief.
- the Lord to pinpoint areas of my life that He wants me to really invest in e.g. work colleagues, netball team, outreach at church etc.

LEGACY FUND UPDATE - AUTUMN 2023





Christ Church Ware (CCW) donated £11,500 to INF as part of the legacy project for the supply of 73 special wheelchairs for poor Nepalis with spinal injury.

GREEN PASTURES HOSPITAL (GPH)

The mission of GPH and International Nepal Fellowship (INF) is to transform lives by offering holistic rehabilitation services, fostering independence, and promoting overall wellbeing. Their vision is to be a centre of excellence in rehabilitation, recognised for patient-centric care, advanced medical practices, and community outreach.

INF have served the poor and marginalised people of Nepal for 71 years.

IMPROVED QUALITY OF LIFE IN NEPAL

Min Bahadur Gurung (aged 37) is from Gorkha District, Nepal. He fell five years ago in the forest while collecting fodder. What a devastating accident anywhere but particularly for a poor hill farmer and often a death sentence and an economic tragedy for the family. Since his accident, Min's brother has looked after his two children because his wife Bimala needs to give constant care at home.

Min had a basic old wheelchair but the specialist rehab team at GPH found it was unsuitable because it was causing recurrent pressure ulcer and sores.

Bimala and the GPH rehab team are hopeful that the new wheelchair will improve Min's quality of life mobility and they can prevent further pressure sores and infection.
