Bible verse

STAINED GLASS WINDOW

How to make a stained glass window



You will need: Black card Tissue paper Glue Pencil (white would be best)

Draw out your design onto the card. You might want to practice on another piece of paper.

Carefully cut out the bits that you want to be colourful



Stick the tissue paper to the card

Stick up in your window!

ACTIVITIES

Stained Glass Star Biscuits




Ingredients: 150g butter, softened 100g sugar 1 large egg 250g plain flour 1tsp baking powder 1 pinch salt 1tbsp mixed spice 1tsp vanilla extract 1 pack boiled coloured sweets

- 1. Preheat the oven to 180C and line a baking tray with parchment paper.
- 2. Using an electric hand whisk, whisk together the butter and sugar in a large bowl until light and creamy.
- 3. Add the egg and mix thoroughly.
- 4. Sift in the flour, baking powder, salt, and mixed spice and then add the vanilla extract.
- 5. Mix with a wooden spoon until you reach a biscuit dough consistency.
- 6.Turn the dough onto a floured work surface and roll out to about 1cm/½in thick.
- 7. Cut out star shapes and place onto the lined baking tray.
- 8. Using a smaller cutter or a small knife cut out the centre of each biscuit.
- 9. Place a boiled sweet into the hole (cut in half if your hole is smaller than 2.5cm/1in) and place in the preheated oven to cook for 15 minutes, or until golden-brown and crisp with the sweet melted.
- 10. If you want to hang them, poke a hole in the top before they cool and once cool thread string/ribbon through.
