Make a Barn

Find different grains in your house- rice, oats, lentils. Use these to create a picture to help you remember today's parable.

A great verse to learn!

Then Jesus said to them, "Be careful and guard against all kinds of greed. A man's life is not measured by the many things he owns."

You might like to write this out and put it somewhere to help you remember it.

The man had so much that he had to build a bigger barn. What do you think he could have done with it instead? He could have shared what he had with other people instead of storing it all up for himself. He died before he got to enjoy it.

When we die we can't take our belongings with us.

The story reminds us that we should put God first in our lives and avoid greed by being grateful for what we already have.

It isn't wrong to have nice things but we just need to make sure they don't become the most important things in our life. God should be the most important.



Snack time!



Build a biscuit barn using biscuits and icing! Rectangular biscuits would work best but use anything you have! As you eat it remember the man in the story who built a bigger barn to keep all his corn in instead of sharing it with others.

Spend some time asking God to show you what you have been storing up or placing above him. Write down or draw what you think God may be saying to you.

Pray and ask Him to help you be generous with what you have and to help you put Him first.
