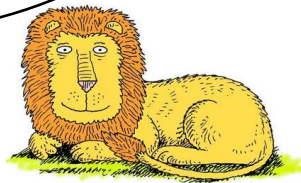


TRUSTING GOD at ALL times

Read the story of Daniel
in the lions' den
Find it in Daniel chapter 6



Think about...

Daniel loved God and wanted to obey him. But this meant that sometimes he would have to make difficult choices about what to do and how to behave in a way that pleased God.

Sometimes in life we face difficult decisions about how to respond and behave in situations. It might look different to what our friends are doing. Can you think of a time when you had to do this?

In these times we need to keep praying, reading our Bibles and looking to Jesus as this will help us to know what to do.

Game- Sleeping Lions

Everyone (except one hunter) lie down on the floor in sleeping positions like a lion. The lions are then not allowed to move. The hunter will walk through the room and try to make the sleeping lions move by making them laugh, telling jokes etc...

However, the hunters are not allowed to touch the lions.

Once any lion moves they are tapped and get up and join the hunters.

The last child (or adult) still on the floor wins!

Activity

Have fun making a picture of the lions' den. I used cake cases and colouring pens and pencils but you can use whatever you have available in the house. If you don't have cake cases you could use paper. Get creative with the den!

AMEN

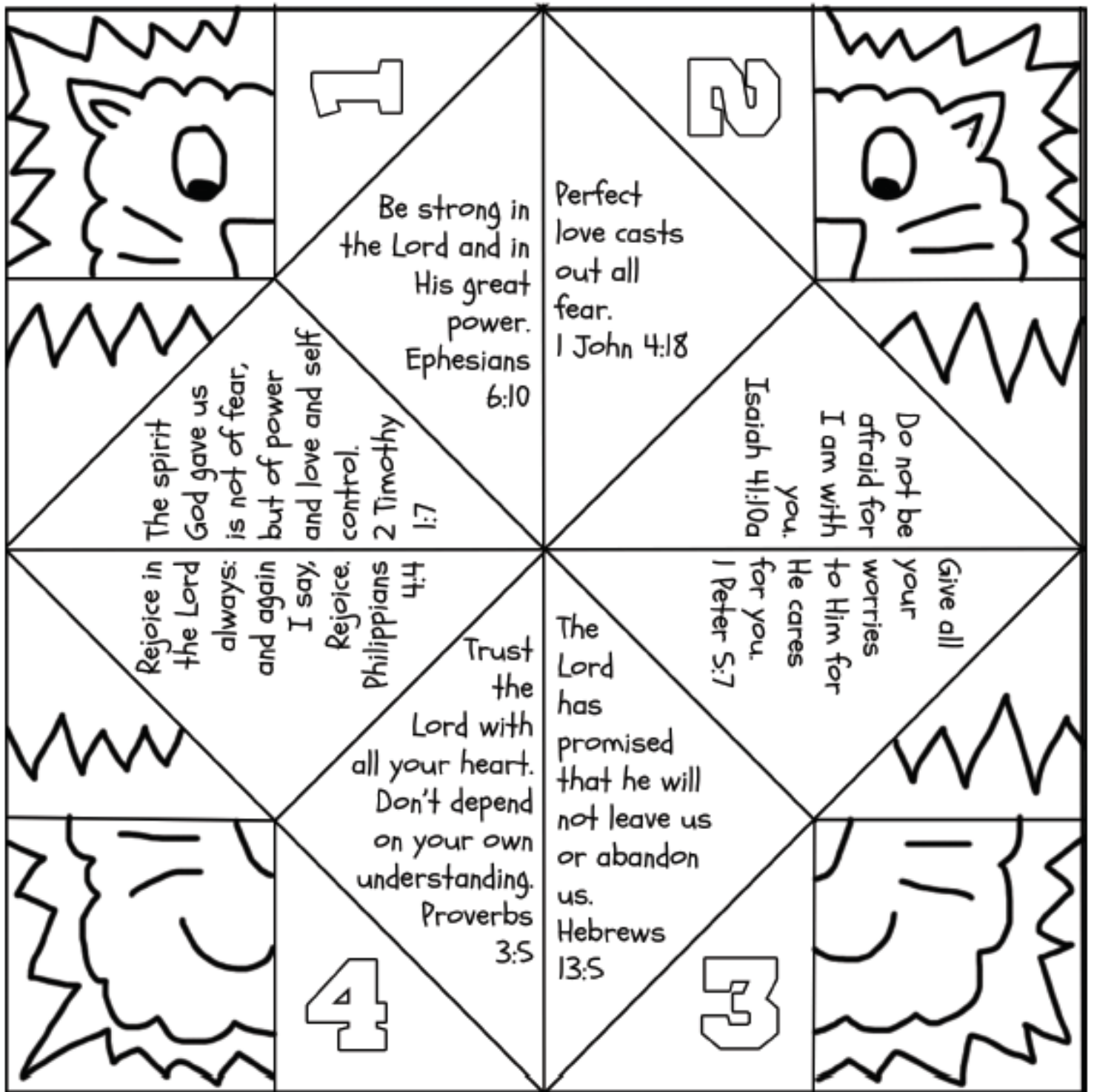
Activity – Origami Lion

Color the printable and then cut out the square. Fold the square in half and then in half again. Unfold the paper and fold the corners into the centre of the square. Turn the paper over and fold the new corners into the centre of the square. Fold it back in half. Place your fingers under the flaps and move it back and forth. Ask your friends to choose a corner of the lion to open and see which verse they get!
